






**ALUMNADO, silencio

They offer a guide to families to prepare or stimulate children to be more successful at school.






Some cultural contrasts

- As you can see in the slides, in Canadian schools we can find relevant differences in values and norms with our educative system. Some of them include:
 - Respect children rhythm, nutrition, playground and recreation.
There are two 20m recess and one large playground time with snacks and lunch moments. In addition, every few minutes they stand up and move following a rhythmic activity. Drama and dance lessons in the schedule help to implement mental and physical well-being. The huge size of the classrooms let do these kind of activities without overlimiting the individual space.
 - Respect for children privacy. No children pictures you can see in the slides. Ontario rules are very strict with this fact, school social media where children can be released are banned.
 - Different daily routines, After afternoon there is not activities outside for children, they stay with families. They have dinner at 5pm and then rest and they spend time with family.
 - Fields with trees and gardens, soft ground made of milled trees peels in the zone of kids playground.
 - The teachers have access to a very good and quality resources and material. There are not books.
 - Technology is basic. There is not computers for children, but there are smart boards and projector, or 5 tablets per group. They work on paper not on digital devices.
 - Lot of collaboration families and school. Different ways of that. Library forum, classroom activities, one Friday every four weeks is not instructive day, dedicated to families.

Algunhas diferencias

- Na presentación podesen apreciar algunhas diferencias co noso sistema educativo, algunhas son as seguintes.
- Máximo respeto polos dereitos fundamentais do infante, ritmo do alumnado, nutrición e xogos. Tres descansos ao longo da xornada para alimentarse e moverse nos patios, ademáis de actividades guiadas de ritmo e movemento cada poucos minutos nas grandes aulas donde non se invaden os espacios privados. Ademáis de dúas materias como son danza e drama, fundamentais para o ben estar mental e físico.
- Máximo respeto pola privacidade e tratamento da imaxe do infante en redes sociais ou en prensa ou por particulares. No reportaxe non hai imaxes nin de alumnado nin de profesorado. Prohibida a publicación ou publicidade de imaxes.
- Estilo e vida moi acorde coa vida en familia, a partir das 4 da tarde non hai actividades fora das casas. As cinco cenan nas súas casas descansan e realizan tarefas coa familia.
- Os espacios físicos diferentes, grandes corredores e aulas, os patios son campos ou espacios naturais de xabre ou unha especie de restos de corteza ou vexetación moi mullida na zona dos xogos infantis. Non se ven patios de cemento.
- O profesorado ten acceso a bons recursos e materiais, non hai libros de texto.
- O alumnado traballa en formato papel, non en formato dixital.
- Apreciase moito intercambio de actividades familias centro escolar. Un venres ao mes non lectivo, dedicado a partir coas familias, e a reunións de seguimento.
